

Friends of Longford Park Picture Trails Lesson Plan



Approximate duration:	20 - 30 minutes.
Suitable for:	Key Stage 1 and 2.
Learning objective:	Pupils locate photographs on a plan of the park.
Overview:	Pupils walk around the park marking the locations of photographs on the worksheet onto the map. The photo-worksheets can be completed independently or linked together to form a longer exercise. The exercise will work better if different groups start from different points rather than all clustering together.
Location:	Southern part of the park.
Materials required:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Park map• Photograph worksheet• Pens



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Session Plan: Children work in small groups to walk around the park and identify each photograph on the map. Each group should be accompanied by an adult. They can decide their own starting point, in fact it is much better if groups start at different points. There are two picture worksheets for the park, these can be completed separately or linked together for a longer activity.
For younger children worksheets can be used as spotter sheets where children can tick which ones they spot on a walk through the park.

Teachers Notes: Worksheet 1 involves children walking in a circle along the Avenue, southern perimeter of the park, along edge of tennis courts, Longford Hall, pets Corner.
Worksheet 2 involves children walking east from Longford Hall through the formal gardens, returning to the hall.
