Paths

The main park paths are mostly smooth asphalt. The path around the southern perimeter of the park running between the Cromwell Road and Edge Lane entrances around to the entrance to the tennis courts is not surfaced in any way and can be muddy following wet weather. This path forms part of the Picture Trail activity.

Part of the area between the former Longford Hall and the Pets Corner has stone cobbles. This area forms part of one of the Picture Trail activities although it is possible to reach that part of the Trail on smooth paths from the formal gardens.

Steps and kerbs

There are a series of short staircases within the footprint of the former Longford Hall although it is possible to reach the former front door and facade using the main paths.

Gates

The play area near the former Longford Hall and Pets' Corner are both enclosed and have gates which must be pushed open to enter. The equipment in this play area is used for several of the Forces lessons.
