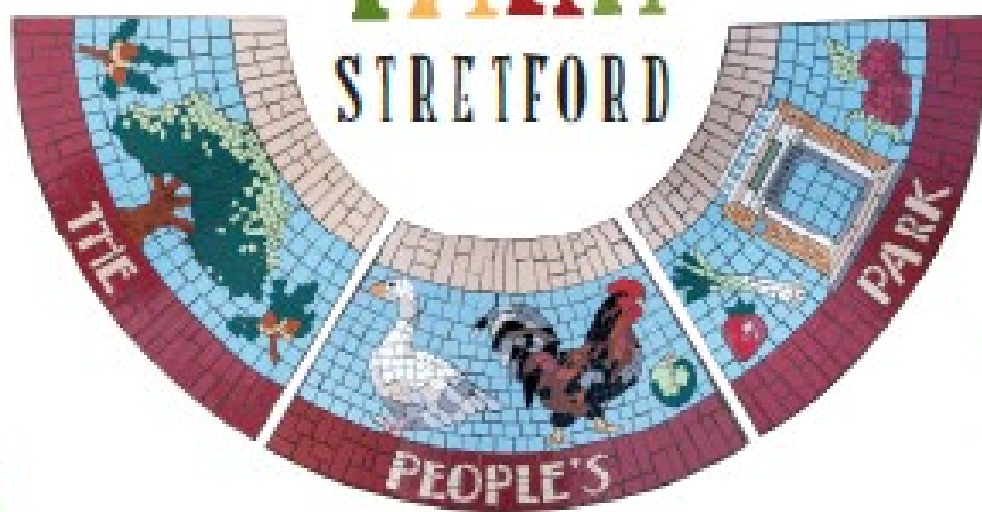

Friends Update:

National Lottery Heritage Fund: a grant of £3.1 million is due to be signed off in March, with actual work starting circa September 2024.

Garden of Reflection: We are creating a little Garden of Reflection near the former shelters in the ornamental gardens, where we'll have a plaque or mosaic to remember those who lost their lives or were injured in the Manchester Arena Bombing of 2017. We have put in new plants and will be getting two new benches.

Cycle secure storage: FOLP have been successful in an application for a cycle shelter at the Firswood Centre cycle stands near the Scouts hut, and also to repair the cycle shelter roof at the athletics track.

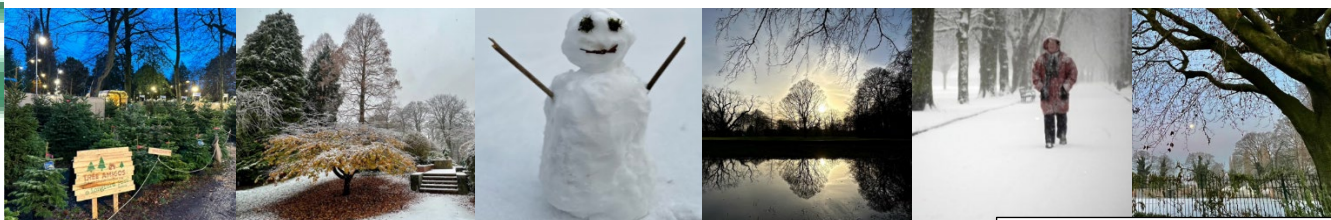
